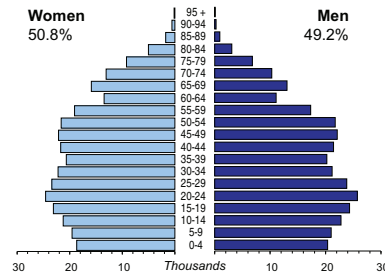

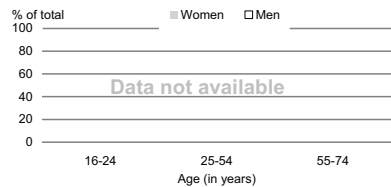

Computer use by age and sex

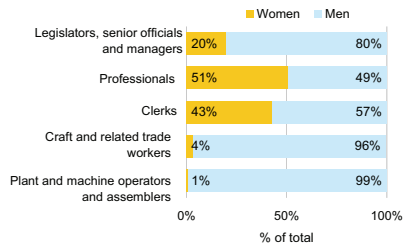

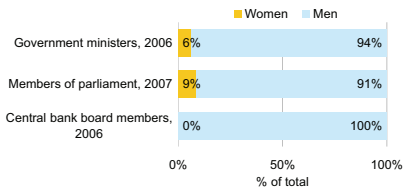

Employment by occupation groups, 2005:



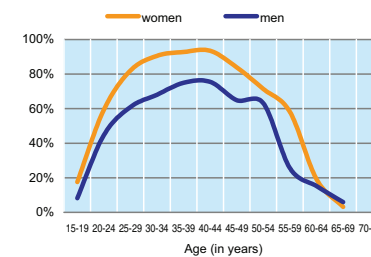

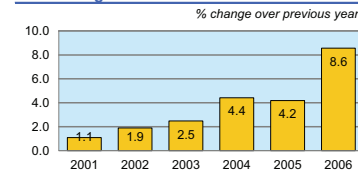

Economic activity rate, 2005

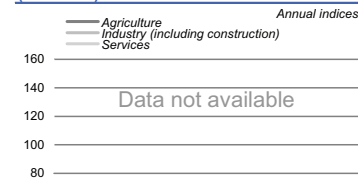


Real GDP growth rate

GDP in agriculture, industry, and services (2005=100)

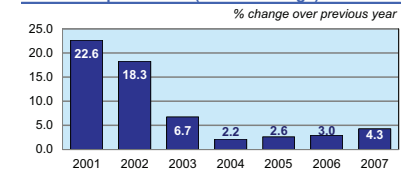

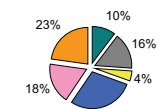

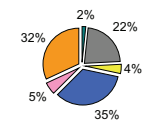
Consumer price index (annual average)
